- Supervise a successful advancement program
- Implement the outlined Cub Scout program
- Coordinate den participation at monthly pack meeting
- Maintain standards of the Church and BSA
- Ensure two-deep leadership at all activities
- Work closely with Cubmaster
- Integrate Faith in God requirements into den efforts
- Keep it simple, make it fun!!
